Baked Brunch Omelete



“A baked egg casserole with cheese, ham & green onions.”

INGREDIENTS

1/2 loaf white bread, cut into cubes
3 Cups Cheddar Cheese shredded
8 Eggs
2 Cups Milk / 1 Pinch of salt
1 dash hot pepper sauce, or to taste
1/4 Cup Chopped green onions

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly grease 9x13” backing pan

2. Place half of the bread cubes on bottom of pan. Sprinkle with half the ham & then half the cheese: repeat.
3. In a large bowl, beat together eggs, milk, salt, hot sauce & green onions. Pour egg mixture into the pan.
4. Place pan on top of a baking sheet with a rim and place in the oven. Pour water into baking sheet and bake for 60 minutes, or until eggs have set.
